### Arrangements in line with our COVID-19 Workplace Risk Assessment children who are accessing provision onsite

I hope you are continuing to keep well in these challenging and difficult times. We will be continuing to adhere to our COVID-19 Workplace Risk Assessment to keep our children, families and staff as safe as we can.

School remains open, and the offer of education will continue to be:

- Places onsite will be available for children of critical workers where this is required and those whose learning is more vulnerable as a priority.
- Some children may access a 'blended learning' offer – accessing some sessions onsite but also accessing the remote learning activities that are being sent to you on a text link and posted on Facebook.
- Some children will access remote learning at home only, these learning opportunities are sent to you on a text link and posted on Facebook.
