Dear Parents/Carers

Coronavirus symptoms

Please see advice below:

- Any child showing one or more of the symptoms of COVID-19 (new continuous cough, high temperature or loss/change in sense of taste/smell) should remain at home. If your child displays these symptoms in Nursery, we will contact you and ask that you collect your child straight away.
- We would advise that your child then has a PCR test, and if positive, your child must remain at home and complete the isolation period. You can book a test at: https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting
- We ask that you show the result of your child's test either to Reception, the Office, Nursery classroom staff or email a screen shot to: parents1041@welearn365.com
- If you choose not to get your child PCR tested, your child **must** remain at home and **isolate for 10 days** from the onset of symptoms. After the isolation period, the child can return to Nursery if they are well enough.
- We would ask you to be alert for any of the less common symptoms of COVID-19 sore throat, headache, fatigue, muscle aches, and we would advise parents/carers to get your child PCR tested, particularly if we have informed you we have COVID-19 cases in Nursery. Please see the flow chart below.
