Dear Parents/Carers

### Positive COVID case

We have had another positive COVID case in the Nursery School. As the individual has not been onsite for well over a week there is **no** need for us to close either our Big Nursery or Little Nursery bubble. However, this does indicate that we have COVID-19 in our School community and I would ask therefore that you remain especially vigilant over the coming days. Could we please remind parents/carers:

- To not send your child to either Big or Little Nursery if they are at all unwell.
- If your child presents with any of the classic COVID-19 symptoms (a high temperature, continuous cough or a change/loss of taste or smell,) please book a PCR test for your child and your household and inform us of the results, or self-isolate with your child for 10 days.
- Postal PCR COVID tests are available for your Nursery School child, please ask at reception and let us know your child's result.
- To be aware that COVID-19 can present differently in children (please see flow chart below).

### Lateral flow test device (LFD) Testing:

LFDs are used for testing for people who are showing no symptoms. This is an additional tool to identify COVID-19 cases, contain the virus and prevent its transmission. Households, childcare and support bubbles of primary and secondary-age pupils and staff can now take twice-weekly lateral flow tests. Any pupils or students receiving any positive LFD test result should immediately follow the isolation advice for themselves, their household and close contacts and they must seek a confirmatory PCR test.
