Dear Parents/Carers

Children who are feeling unwell

We are currently seeing a number of children attend their session who are not feeling well for a variety of reasons and are displaying a range of different symptoms.

When considering the well-being of children and their capacity to be well enough to engage in a Nursery session, and also being mindful of our COVID Workplace Risk Assessment, could we please remind parents and carers:

- To not send their child to either Big or Little Nursery if they are unwell.
- Postal PCR COVID tests are available for your Nursery School child, please ask at reception.
- To be aware that COVID-19 can present differently in children (please see flow chart below). However if your child is displaying any of the 3 main of symptoms of COVID 19 – new or continuous cough, temperature or loss of taste or smell, then you will need to either arrange a PCR test for your child or ensure they self-isolate for 10 days.

If a child presents as unwell during session, staff will contact you and ask for you to collect your child.
